Dear Residents, Resident Family Members and Resident Emergency Contacts:

We have recently been given new guidance on visitation at Homme Home by our Federal and State Regulators. The new guidance allows for less restrictive visits with your loved ones. Previous to this guidance, when Shawano County's COVID-19 positivity rate was 10% or higher, visitation was to be cancelled. With the new guidance, there is more flexibility in offering general indoor visitation to residents who are fully vaccinated at times when the county positivity rate is 10% or higher. As new residents admit we are able to arrange the COVID-19 vaccine through Gwidt Pharmacy if they are interested.

1. All visits must be scheduled in advance and will be scheduled by calling (715) 253-2125.
2. Once visits are scheduled, nursing home visitors will check in at the main lobby and CBRF visitors will check in at the main CBRF entrance (across the street from Alpha House Resale Shop).
3. Visits will occur in the resident's room. If a resident has a roommate, the visits will need to occur in a lounge or common space.
4. Visits will be limited to 45 minutes; this will ensure all residents have an opportunity to visit their family.
5. Visitors must pre-screen themselves 24 hours in advance of the visit as well as 1 hour in advance of the visit for fever and signs and symptoms of COVID-19.
6. All visitors will need to be screened for fever and signs and symptoms of COVID-19 upon entrance of Homme's property and sign an attestation that they also understand the risk of the visit to the resident. The visitor will also be screened to ensure that they have not been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days. The visit will be cancelled if visitors have symptoms or has been in contact with a positive COVID-19 person in the last 14 days.
7. Social distancing must always be maintained between the visitor and resident. This is a minimum of six feet. If a resident is fully vaccinated, the resident may engage in touch, including hand holding, but the resident and visitor must wear well-fitting face masks.
8. Visitors and residents must both complete appropriate hand hygiene before and after the visit. (we will provide hand sanitizer at our screening area).

9. Visitors and residents must wear a face covering/mask during the entire visit. Visitors must bring their own face covering. Face covering can be homemade or purchased at a store, i.e. Walmart / Target. Residents will be provided with a face covering.
10. No more than two (2) visitors may be with any one resident at a time.
11. Visitors should be of an age in which they are able to keep a mask on for the duration of the visits, and visitors under the age of 12 must be in control of the adult that brings them and must comply to social distancing.
12. If staff witnesses visitors not wearing masks or not following standards, visitors will be requested to leave.
