Thank you for your interest in the Pine City Ambassador Program, a committee supported by the Pine City Area Chamber of Commerce. We welcome your questions as you consider your application to participate in the program.

Candidate Eligibility

1. Completed 11th grade at Pine City Public Schools in the 2020-2021 school year OR confirmed applicant from 2020 program (cancelled due to COVID-19).
2. Current resident with a physical address within the Pine City School District boundaries.
3. Students that are enrolled in Pine City Public Schools, but do not live within the school district boundaries may be eligible to participate if their parent owns a business belonging to the Pine City Area Chamber of Commerce for at least one year prior to May 1st.

Candidate Application

1. Candidates must complete the application packet with information that will help us get to know each of the candidates and their interests. Submit the completed application form to the Pine City Area Chamber by Friday, July 16th by noon with \$25 the application fee.
2. Secure a \$100 Pine City Area Business Sponsorship (completed sponsorship form is due July 16th) (payment & ad copy due July 30th at noon). The sponsorship fee will cover a candidate t-shirt, snacks & activities.

GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS

Candidate Program

CANDIDATE MISSION STATEMENT

To provide local youth a unique opportunity to become actively involved in the representation of their community through a competition involving community involvement and an opportunity to practice positive social skills with area businesses, organizations and community members.

APPAREL GUIDELINES

Community Events/Activities:

- Candidate t-shirt (provided), capris/pants/shorts/skirt (khaki, black or white suggested), appropriate shoes (no flip-flops, please)

Senior Candidate Activity Week Exceptions:

- Candidate luncheon and interview session: Job interview outfit is acceptable.
- Coronation: Evening gown, dress shoes (straps suggested)

CANDIDATE CODE OF CONDUCT

- Treat all Community events/activities, other contestants, and Ambassador Committee Members with respect
- Perform to the best of your ability not only in public, but also in all aspects of your life such as church and school.
- Conduct yourself in a manner that respects the community of Pine City, its citizens, and the laws that affect Pine City.
- Follow apparel guidelines as noted above, or committee approved attire, at all events and public appearances.
- Candidates are discouraged from wearing any visible, body-pierced jewelry, other than earrings, at all events and public appearances. Tattoos and other body art also need to be covered or presented in a tasteful manner.
- Be on-time at all scheduled program events.
- Return all phone calls and e-mail messages promptly regarding community events and public appearances.
- Communicate any schedule conflicts with the Candidate Coordinator promptly.
- Restrict cell phone use to emergencies only, and obtain permission from a committee member prior to using your cell phone. Please make sure cell phones are turned off when program activities begin.

Any candidate who does not adhere to the Code of Conduct guidelines could be dismissed at the discretion of the Program Committee.

Grounds for Dismissal from Ambassador Candidate Program

The Ambassador Program Committee will have the sole discretion to dismiss a candidate for conduct that is determined to be detrimental to the mission of the Program, Candidates, Volunteers, Ambassadors and/or activities. Dismissal will result in the loss of the right to compete, scholarship, awards, and participation in scheduled events. Following are potential situations that could result in dismissal: conviction of a crime, pregnancy or marriage, illegal or misuse of drugs, alcohol or smoking - during competition period.

If selected as an Ambassador for Pine City, a similar, and more detailed Code of Conduct will take effect and be reviewed with Ambassadors and families the week following Coronation.

PINE CITY AMBASSADOR PROGRAM CANDIDATE SPONSORSHIP

NEW SPONSORSHIP PROCESS THIS YEAR! Since the ambassador program is off to a later start this year, we have adjusted the sponsorship process. All candidates are asked to obtain a \$100 Candidate Sponsorship from a Pine City Area Business. Business Sponsorships help to fund the expenses for candidate activities and Coronation Night.

Sponsorship Form: Your sponsor should complete a form with their information. It is important to get a phone number or email address should we need to contact them regarding their ad, and the mailing address is important so that you are able to follow-up with a thank you note.

- If you contact a business and have to leave them a form, be sure to put your name and phone number at the top of the form for them to follow-up with you.
- Be sure to ask if they have an ad that they will be emailing, want to use a previous ad, or get a business card for an ad to be created.
- Some businesses may not be able to sponsor an individual candidate, but are able to sponsor the program. Leave them a form and they can follow-up with **Becky (320-322-4040)** if they have questions.

A complete sponsorship packet will include a form, payment, and ad copy or business card if applicable.

All completed sponsorship packets are due to be turned in by Friday, July 30th to the Pine City Area Chamber of Commerce. Packets not received by the deadline will be considered late and noted on your Candidate Program Participation.

Who should I ask to sponsor me??

Any Pine City Area business can be a sponsor. Each business can only sponsor one candidate. If you need assistance, we have a list of businesses available that you can contact.

Tips for Getting Sponsorships

- DO ask the businesses that you work for or are a frequent customer at – your dentist, your bank, your favorite store, etc. If you are able to connect on a personal level with the business, they are more likely to sponsor you.
- Ask friends and family who own their own business or work for an area business.
- DON'T wait. There could be up to 40 candidates (Senior and Junior) looking for sponsorship.
- DON'T go out as a group or even in pairs to ask for sponsorships.
- DON'T contact service organizations like the Pine Area Lions, Pine City Lions, Snowmobile Clubs, etc. These groups are solicited by the program and will not support single candidates.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

IF YOUR CANDIDATE IS SELECTED AS A PINE CITY AMBASSADOR

- The 2021-22 Pine City Ambassadors receive a crown/tiara and sash. The Pine City Ambassador program will purchase one formal gown to be worn to formal events and name tag to be worn to community engagement events during the program year.
- If the Ambassador attire items go over the budget, the Ambassador families may be responsible for the additional expense. Additional expenses may also include a winter hat/headband, mittens, scarf, snow pants, boots, sandals, comfortable walking shoes, shorts/skirt.
- There are a few parades that require additional decorations to the Ambassador float. The Ambassador families are responsible for redecorating the float for themed events, such as the Pine City Holiday Madness Parade, the Anoka Halloween parade and the Cambridge Snowflake Parade. There will be some time involved in this process. The program will reimburse Ambassador families for pre-approved expenses. The Ambassadors may also be required to wear costumes.
- Consider this to be like a public relations job for the Pine City Ambassador Program. It is a commitment for your family, as they will be involved with the parades almost as much as the Ambassadors.
- Ambassador families will take turns driving the float to parades and will be responsible for providing a truck to pull the float. Oftentimes, a truck can be borrowed from a local dealership. The Scheduling Coordinator will help you with this process.
- Ambassador families may also be required to serve as the chaperone for the Ambassadors when visiting other communities.
- Ambassador families may have the opportunity to participate in fundraising activities throughout the program year. If an Ambassador group chooses to do additional fundraising to support optional opportunities, ALL Ambassador families are expected to participate/contribute.

PLEASE talk about this commitment with ALL of your family members so that any concerns or questions that they may have can be answered. Again, this is a huge (and fun!) commitment for the whole family. This can be a very special and wonderful experience for the whole family for a year, one that they may never have considered before - seeing new places, meeting many different people, and making new friends.

The Pine City Ambassador program is hosted by the Pine City Chamber of Commerce and the committee is made up of dedicated volunteers.
