



COVID-19 Specific Information for Field Trips

Before the Program: In order for our time together to be most successful, please do the following things.

- 1) Share with us your screening plan. We are able to temperature screen participants and chaperones if this is something that has not already been done by you prior to your arrival at Moore Road Farm on the day of your trip.
- 2) Share with us how your students are grouped during their time with you so we can be mindful of how we group your students during their time with us.

Important Information to share with students/parents:

- 1) All STEM Connection staff is screened daily.
- 2) All work areas, restrooms, and hand-washing stations are sanitized multiple times every day.
- 3) Materials are sanitized after use and participants are instructed to clean/sanitize hands before and after using shared materials. We make every effort to be mindful of who touching is what and how items are being shared among participants.
- 4) We have washing stations, hand sanitizer, etc. available with time built in to use these resources.
- 5) Please bring labeled water bottles for every participant and chaperone. We have refill stations available, but bringing your own water bottles helps to avoid sharing germs.
- 6) All activities will take place outdoors. Please have participants and chaperones apply sunscreen and bug spray before or upon arrival.
- 7) Masks will be provided to those that do not have one in the event that participants and chaperones need to unexpectedly shelter indoors.

If there were to be a positive case among staff or a program participant at Moore Road Farm within the week of your field trip, your field trip would be rescheduled.
