## Turning Point is Looking For Volunteers

Turning Point, which is a day resource center for persons who are homeless or have issues of impending homelessness, is looking for volunteers. Volunteer Responsibilities include – commit to at least one three hour shift at least one day each week (9am to noon); honor the Turning Point Confidentiality Agreement; answering phones and scheduling appointments; provide referrals to other agencies; offer emergency food, toiletries, and clothing; conduct client intake interviews; maintain client files; attend team meetings (every 6 weeks); demonstrate client advocacy. Required Skills – Team player; integrity, compassion and the ability to work with a diverse population; welcoming interpersonal skills; active listening skills; basic computer skills. Instruction and training provided.

Turning point is also looking to expand its list of volunteers who may be available to provide occasional support of turning point programs. Tasks may include the pick-up and delivery of goods and supplies; volunteer assistance to fulfill Turning Point community outreach programs such as our Holiday Program; time and talent in support of our various fund raising initiatives.
