Vineyard Community Services & Fruit of the Vine Food Shelf

I am eligible to receive TEFAP commodity food because:

-  I am in Minnesota and
-  My household income is 200% or less of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
-  I am also eligible if I receive or participate in the following services and programs: MFIP (Minnesota Family Investment Program), Child Care Assistance, GA (General Assistance), Head Start, SNAP (Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program), Section 8, NAPS (Nutritional Assistance Program for Seniors), Public Housing, WIC (Women, Infants, and Children), Energy Assistance, Free and reduced breakfast and lunch, Weatherization
-  Eligibility is granted to all persons in distress and emergency situations due to disasters.

Your Privacy Rights

You have rights under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act. This Act protects your privacy, but also lets us give information about you to others if a law requires it AND we tell you before we do it.

-  We are asking you for this information so we can:
 - ✓ Tell you from other persons by the same or similar name
 - ✓ Decide if you can receive services from us and what or how much you can get
 - ✓ Report to the government so we can continue to provide these services.
-  Generally, you are not required to give us the information. However, if you do not give us the information, we may not be able to determine whether we can help you.
-  The law allows us to share your information with staff from the Minnesota Department of Human Services, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), and others who may need to view your information in order to do their jobs.
-  You have the right to copies of information we have about you. If you do not understand the information, you may have it explained to you. If you do not think the information is accurate or complete, you may object in writing to the food shelf director. Sus Derecho de privacidad

Usted tiene derechos bajo the Minnesota Government data practices Act. Esta ley protege su privacidad, pero también nos permite dar información sobre usted a terceros si la ley lo requiere y nosotros le informaremos antes de hacerlo.

- 🍇 Le estamos pidiendo esta información para que nosotros podamos:
 - ✓ Distinguirle a usted de otras personas con el mismo nombre.
 - ✓ Decidir si usted puede recibir servicios de nosotros y qué o cuánto usted puede recibir.
 - ✓ Informar al gobierno para que podamos seguir ofreciendo estos servicios.
- 🍇 Generalmente, usted no está obligado a dar la información. Sin embargo, si no nos dan la información, no podremos determinar si podemos ayudarle.
- 🍇 La ley nos permite compartir la información con el personal del departamento de servicios humanos de Minnesota, el Departamento de Estados Unidos de Agricultura (USDA), y otros que puedan necesitar para ver su información con el fin de hacer su trabajo.
- 🍇 Usted tiene el derecho de recibir copias de la información que tenemos sobre usted. Si usted no entiende la información, es posible que se lo expliquen a usted. Si usted no cree que la información sea precisa o completa, usted podrá oponerse por escrito al director del banco de alimentos.
