Course Objectives:

- Learn and understand the history and basics of Fashion Design
- Make a mood board for a collection drawn from original inspiration - Learn the steps to design a fashion collection on paper
- Learn to use Digital Fashion Pro v8 to create artful presentations
- With confidence and professionalism present designs

Week 1: Introduction to Class

All about Fashion Design- history of fashion and important designers

Inspiration- where do designers get their ideas? How do fashion designers create collections?

Week 2: Designing a Collection

Inspiration/Mood boards- create a collage using images from magazines/catalogs/internet/photos as inspiration for a clothing collection Fabric Lecture- creating a swatch collection

Week 3: Fashion Sketching on Paper

How to draw fashion figures, flat sketches

Incorporate design elements and principles of form and shape Design 3 looks inspired from week 2 mood boards

Week 4: Using Digital Fashion Pro v8

Introduction to Digital Fashion Pro program to draw fashion sketches hand sketched in Week 3
Discussion on the importance of technology in the Fashion Industry

Week 6: Fashion Sketching in Digital Fashion Pro

Week 7: Creating Fabrics in Digital Fashion Pro

Week 8: Creating Fashion Figures in Digital Fashion Pro

Week 9: Dressing Fashion Figures with original designs in Digital Fashion Pro

Week 9: Creating an artful presentation

Putting together a fashion line for presentation using mood board/hand sketches/digital images.
Creating and embellishing presentation boards with sketches, fabrics, trims, etc.

Week 10: Presentations

Students will present their final collections before peers and receive feedback. Have a special guest from the fashion industry to give them feedback
