What are the minimum grade entry requirements?

To join the Volkswagen Group apprenticeship programme, applicants must have achieved or be predicted to achieve GCSE grades 9 -4 (A-C) or equivalent in English, Maths and Science. Applicants must be aged 16 or over and have the right to work in the UK.
