Social Distancing Guidelines for Reopening GCCC Sanctuary for Worship Services

As we prepare to re-open for in person services at GCCC the following guidelines that will be in place for everyone's safety. I believe these guides will only needed for a short time.

1. We encourage Social distancing of 6 feet. We ask that you refrain from fellowshiping in the building. Please refrain from hugging, handshaking or other means of close contact.
2. GCCC Worship center has been thoroughly professionally cleaned and prepared for for our in person worship. We have ordered air purifiers for the sanctuary.
3. Please remain at home and continue to enjoy the service via Facebook Live, YouTube or www.greenvillecommunitychristian.com of the following apply to you:
 - a. If you or members of you household have been exposed to Covid 19 and have not been cleared by doctor.
 - b. If have a fever or symptoms of illness in you or members of your household.
 - c. Underlying health conditions or compromised immune system.
 - d. Hesitancy because of your age or other reasons that makes you uncomfortable or reluctant at this time. We will see you soon.
4. Please enter through East Side canopy for 8:15 service(exist East Side also) and Main entrance for 10 am service.
5. Please follow the ushers directions fo seating and existing. Please wait to be seated and wait to be directed to exit once service is dismissed. Seating will be every other row.
6. Families will be seated together and the next person or family will be seated 2 or more seats away.
7. Everyone may wear masks and/or gloves if they desire. Please respect the choices of your brothers and sisters.
8. The following ministries will open at a later time:
 - a. Nursery
 - b. Children's Church
 - c. Transportation Ministry
 - d. Outreach
 - e. Choir (Praise Team, Musicians and Soloist will continue to minister in music)
 - f. Hospitality Visitors Reception
9. Please pick up your offering envelope as you enter sanctuary and put offering in containers near the exits at the close of service as you leave sanctuary.
10. Continue in faith and prayer. Looking forward to being able to return to worshipping without restrictions and with all ministries operating soon.
