The following positions are leadership opportunities and serve on a committee. They do not require that you lead a den. All Committee positions attend a monthly Committee Meeting from August to May.

COMMITTEE CHAIR works with Minsi Trails Council to keep the pack a Chartered Organization. Provides supervision during monthly pack meetings, plans, prepares and leads the monthly committee meetings, assigns duties to members of the Pack Committee, ensures all committee members are trained, maintains pack records and works with the CubMaster

TREASURER manages funds for the pack and maintains pack bank account. Keeps track of den dues, writes checks for expenses, compiles a treasurers report for monthly committee meetings.

CUBMASTER helps with recruitment, guides and supports den leaders. Plans, prepares and leads monthly pack meetings with help from Assistant CubMaster.

ASSISTANT CUBMASTER participates in monthly pack meetings, helps with pack activities.

SECRETARY attends monthly committee meetings and writes up minutes. Keeps health forms and application forms

ADVANCEMENT CHAIR encourages scouts to earn their patches, belt loops and pins in Adventures. Accepts den advancements from den leaders and runs a monthly report. Purchases and organizes advancements to present at monthly pack meetings.

POPCORN KERNEL attends a district meeting, and gives annual "kick-off" pep talk in September at Pack Meeting. Keeps records of show-n'-sell totals, maintains stock and recognizes pack for their hard work.

BOD At LARGE attends monthly Board of Committee meetings and gives brief verbal report to Pack at Pack Committee meetings.

DEN LEADER and ASSISTANT DEN LEADER requires leading a den and working with Cub Scouts. May attend monthly Committee Meetings.

The following positions are chairing and serving on a committee of volunteers in order to ensure the fun activities occur.

DAY CAMP DIRECTOR organizes a committee of volunteers, and works with the committee to bring together a fun filled week of activities. Activities are aligned with some Adventure Requirements. Works with Minsi Trails Council for support and to ensure training is complete.

RESIDENT CAMP CHAIR secures a date and location of sleep away camp at Akelaland. Organizes a committee of volunteers, and works with the committee to bring together a fun filled week of activities which are aligned with some Adventure requirements.

MOTHER/SON and FATHER/SON CHAIR secures a date and time of event to sleep over night at Camp Spirit. Organizes a committee of volunteers and works with committee to bring together an evening of fun filled activities.

BLUE AND GOLD CHAIR organizes a committee of volunteers and works with the committee to create a themed banquet. Families sign up to bring food to share. Its a way to recognize our volunteers and raise money for the Pack by hosting a Raffle and Silent Auction.

PINEWOOD DERBY Cub Scouts make a Pinewood Derby car prior to event. A committee of volunteers organizes this event to help the Pinewood Derby competition run smoothly and provide snacks and drinks. Awards are presented at the end of the night.

CUBMOBILE organizes a committee of volunteers and secures a time and date to host the Cubmobile. A friendly competition in racing "go-cart" type cars.

PACK PICNIC sets time and date for family picnic at Camp Spirit during the summer.

SCOUTING FOR FOOD confirms our zone of delivery for Scouting For Food tags. Breaks up our zoned area into manageable delivery areas for our dens. Ensures each den has a representative to deliver collected food to Second Harvest Food Bank after food pick up.

POPCORN DEN REPS each den needs an adult representative to hand out appropriate forms and collect money from their den to pass along to the Treasurer.

POPCORN SHOW N' SELL COORDINATOR ensures there are volunteers and Cub Scouts for each Show N' Sell table outside various locations by setting up sign up sheets for Cub Scouts and adults to volunteer for time slots.
