




2020 PRIMARY SUMMER SCHOOL NEWSLETTER FOXWORTHY CAMPUS July 6th – August 28th



We are thrilled to welcome back your children this summer and will do everything we can to keep them safe and healthy. Our summer program is different from what we offer during the school year. We start the work period at 9:30 am instead of 9:00 am, which gives the children more time to play outside when it's not so hot. Outdoor time will be limited on "Spare the Air" days or when the temperature is over 100 degrees. This summer, we will follow our regular Montessori schedule with minor modifications (see attached daily schedule).

Although it is summer school and things may seem a bit more relaxed, it is still essential for children to have a regular routine, so *it's important that they arrive and be picked up on time*. We cannot stress this enough!

Before your child starts, we ask that you re-read our health and safety protocol so that you are aware of our policies and know what to expect this summer. We have also outlined important details for our summer program below. We all need to work together to ensure the health and safety of everyone on campus, so it's very important that you follow these procedures.

FACE COVERINGS

Anyone on campus (staff, caregivers, parents, children over 2 years old) must wear a face covering at all times.

PICK UP AND DROP OFF

Drop-off and pick-up is outside the building. Each classroom has its own drop-off and pick-up area where staff receive children as they arrive and bring children to be picked up:

- **Primary 3 is outside the entrance to the lobby**
- **Primary 4 is outside the entrance to the office**

Parents/caregivers sign in and out each day on a paper provided *using their own pens* to limit cross-contamination.

We encourage the same family member or designated person to drop off and pick up the child every day. We discourage grandparents and other older relatives from picking up children, if they are over 60 years old, since they are more at risk for serious illness.

Drop off

Before arriving on campus, make sure you understand where to go; parents and children of different classrooms must stay separate at all times. While waiting for a staff member to screen and receive your child, stand on the designated markings on the sidewalk and maintain a distance of 6 feet apart from others at all times. A staff member will be at the door to screen and accept each child from 8:00 am – 8:30 am. If you arrive after 8:30 am, call the school when you have arrived outside your designated entrance and wait for a teacher to receive your child.

Pick up

Children enrolled in the half day and school day programs will be brought to their classroom's pick-up area at 12:00 pm and 3:00 pm respectively. Parents are expected to arrive on time to pick-up their child and stand on the designated markings on the sidewalk while waiting.

SUNSCREEN

Please remember to apply sunscreen on your child in the morning before school. Children enrolled in the school day program will need their own sunscreen at school (see details below) that we will apply after lunch before the children go outside. Note that we must have your signed sunscreen release form to apply sunscreen to your child.

NUT FREE ENVIRONMENT

We have students with severe food allergies to peanuts and tree nuts. Please do not send any peanut or tree nut containing products in your child's lunchbox. For your reference, we listed below the nuts that are not allowed. Alternatives to peanut butter that are acceptable include sun butter and Soy nut butter.

PIZZA HOT LUNCH

We offer an optional pizza hot lunch on Fridays for children enrolled in the school day program. If you wish to participate, please bring \$4 for one slice (\$6 for two slices), which includes a side of fruit/vegetables. The pizza order form and money collection jar will be available at each classroom's designated pick-up and drop-off area. If you are interested in participating, please bring exact change.

ITEMS TO BRING TO SCHOOL



The items that you will need to bring to school are listed below. Each child will have a labeled box in which to store his/her individual items. To limit cross-contamination, it is very important that you package and label each item as described below.

To be brought to school on the first day:

- **Refillable water bottle** (labeled with your child's first name and last initial)
- **Slippers** in an adult-sized shoe box (slippers and box labeled with your child's first name and last initial). Children cannot be in the classroom with bare feet.
- **4 changes of clothes** in individual, sealed zip lock bags (clothing and bags labeled with your child's first name and last initial). We will not provide loaner clothing.
- **Sunscreen** for school day children in a sealed zip lock bag (sunscreen and bag labeled with your child's first name and last initial).
- **2 extra face coverings** in individual, sealed zip lock bags (labeled with your child's first name and last initial)
- **Blanket and optional pillow** if your child naps at school (labeled with your child's first name and last initial). We will provide a washable bag in which to store these napping items.
- **Lunch** for school day children in a sealed lunchbox (preferably not a paper bag) including all utensils. All containers, lids and lunchbox must be labeled with your child's first name and last initial.
- **Wallet-sized or 4 x 6 picture of your child** that will be used to label the storage box of your child's belongings. Note that the picture will not be returned.

To be brought to school daily:

- **Refillable water bottle** (labeled with your child's first name and last initial)
- **Lunch** for school day children in a sealed lunchbox (preferably not a paper bag) including all utensils. All containers, lids and lunchbox must be labeled with your child's first name and last initial.
- **Your own pen** to sign in and out

DAILY SCHEDULE

8:00 - 8:30 am:	Set up classroom/receive children at designated door
8:30 - 9:15 am:	Outside play time
9:15 - 9:30 am:	Snack time
9:30 - 11:30 am:	Work time
11:30 - 12:00 pm:	Circle time
12:00 pm:	Half day children go home
12:00 - 12:45 pm:	Lunch and clean up

12:45 – 1:00 pm: Nappers outside. Non-nappers story time.

Nappers take a nap (1:00 pm to 2:45 pm)

1:00 – 1:30 pm: Outside play time

1:30 – 2:45 pm: Afternoon work time

2:45 – 3:00 pm: Storytime. Nappers wake up.

3:00 pm: School day children go home. School closes.
