FT Khmer Advocate/Prevention Specialist

The Center for Hope and Healing (CHH) is a non-profit organization dedicated to the healing and empowerment of survivors of sexual violence through counseling, trauma-informed advocacy, and to the prevention of sexual violence through community mobilization and education. We are a multicultural organization whose mission is grounded in social justice and to ending intersecting forms of oppression and violence. CHH currently seeks a **Khmer Advocate/Prevention Specialist** for Engaging Men and Boys (EMAB) and Khmer Linguistic Access Program (KLAP). This position is responsible for working on prevention education particularly related to engaging men and boys in redefining definitions of masculinity and preventing sexual violence as well as providing crisis intervention services to Khmer survivors of crime, particularly domestic and sexual violence, human trafficking, and elder abuse.

Responsibilities within the Engaging Men and Boys program include and are not limited to the following:

- Develop and deliver programming to the Khmer community, including the Cambodian Mutual Assistance Association
- Provide training to men and boys on healthy masculinity, bystander intervention, and their roles in preventing sexual violence
- Assist in conducting outreach to organizations and institutions serving young men and boys
- Assist in analyzing evaluation results for each training and adjust curriculum as needed

Responsibilities within the Khmer Linguistic Access Program include and are not limited to the following:

- Provide one on one trauma-based counseling to Khmer survivors of crime, particularly domestic and sexual violence, human trafficking, and elder abuse
- Provide survivors with appropriate referrals and assistance as needed.
- Respond to and assist with survivor-related emergencies, including medical and legal advocacy
- Provide monthly/quarterly reports and statistics for Survivor Services Department
- Provide back-up coverage to 24-hour hotline as needed

Desired Skills/Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in social work, education, psychology, or related field of human services or substantial documented life and work experience
- Minimum 1-2 years' experience in community organizing, violence prevention education, counseling, and related field such as social services.
- Experience developing and implementing culturally competent programs and services with Khmer community.
- Excellent presentations skill and communication skills both verbal/written
- Flexible schedule to be able to work occasional evenings and weekends
- Ability to complete Rape Crisis Counselor training within 6 weeks of hire.
- Fluency in Khmer is a must
- Integrity, strong work ethics, follow through and ability to prioritize multiple tasks
