MOTORCOACH

1 WASHINGTON, PENNSYLVANIA

3 SIGHTSEEING NIAGARA FALLS / TORONTO / LAKE ONTARIO

4 SIGHTSEEING TORONTO

This morning we will have a tour of Toronto with a local guide including the CN Tower. Thrill to the top of the world in only 58 seconds! The former home of Canadian financier Sir Henry Pellatt, Canada's foremost castle is

complete with decorated suites, secret passages, an 800-foot tunnel, towers, stables, and beautiful 5-acre estate gardens. The late afternoon and evening will be free for shopping in the famous Eaton Centre.

5 SAULT STE. MARIE, ONTARIO LAKE HURON

Today we travel north through Barrie and Parry Sound to the mining city of Sudbury, Ontario. By late afternoon, we arrive in the border town of Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, where accommodations await us for two nights.



6 AGAWA CANYON CANADIAN RAILWAY / LAKE SUPERIOR

This morning departing from the Algoma Central Railway/CN depot in downtown Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, this 114-mile excursion truly showcases this rugged beauty that is exclusive to the region. As you settle into your comfortable coach, you can feel the pace of life slow as the experience of a train ride evokes a sense of simpler times. The Northern Ontario wilderness begins to unfold outside the large tinted windows. The seemingly unending mixed forests of the Canadian Shield open up as you skirt the shores of northern lakes and rivers, cross towering trestles, and set eyes on the same rugged landscapes and majestic views that inspired the Group of Seven to create some of Canada's most notable works of art. The excursion is one of North America's iconic rail tours and offers a unique and engaging way to enjoy the rugged beauty that is Northern Ontario. **B D**



7 SOO LOCKS BOAT TOUR / LAKE MICHIGAN / GREENBAY, WISCONSIN

This morning we will take the boat cruise through the American and Canadian Soo Locks. From the moment you step aboard one of the comfortable double-decked Soo Locks tour boats, the adventure of locking through the largest water traffic system on earth begins. We continue south crossing the border back into the USA turning west on US Highway 2 alongside Lake Michigan to Manistique, Michigan for lunch. We continue to Green Bay, Wisconsin for the night.



8 TOUR PACKER'S LAMBEAU FIELD / MILWAUKEE TOUR

Today, we tour the Green Bay Packers Lambeau Field. We walk down the same tunnel the Packer players do on gameday and learn about the legendary history of the team and stadium. The 15,000 square foot, two-level Green Bay Packers Hall of Fame is conveniently located on the main floor of the Lambeau Field Atrium, across from 1919 Kitchen & Tap. Learn all about the incredible history of the Green Bay Packers. We continue to Sheboygan for lunch before continuing to Milwaukee for the night. Milwaukee is the largest city in the state of Wisconsin situated on Lake Michigan's western shore at the confluence of three rivers: the Menomonee, the Kinnickinnic, and the Milwaukee. It's known for its breweries, (over 20 in Milwaukee alone) many of which offer tours chronicling its role in the beer industry. On our guided tour we will see such sites as City Hall, Old World Third Street, Bronze Fonzie, the beautiful Basilica of St. Josephat, Pabst Theater, Pabst Mansion, Milwaukee Public Market, Milwaukee RiverWalk, Discovery World as time permits. Dinner is included this evening in one of Milwaukee's fine restaurants. **D**



9 MARS CHEESE CASTLE / FAIR OAKS FARMS CARMEL, INDIANA

This morning it's a short drive to Kenosha for a visit to Mars Cheese Castle. It's home to Wisconsin-only products, including 700 Different cheeses, sauces, jams, quinces and mustards you can't find anywhere else. There's even a talking cow to educate folks on Wisconsin and the cheese-making process. Recognized as the #1 agritourism destination in the Midwest, Fair Oaks Farms is the nation's leading agriculture attraction located right in the corn belt of Northwest Indiana. It's a place where you can escape to the countryside to learn, dine and unwind. Upon arrival we will enjoy lunch at Fair Oaks Farmhouse Restaurant before visiting the farm. From seed to feed. Learn all about modern crop farming practices, the importance of our soil and the future of farming in order to feed 7 billion people and counting. Visit the Dairy Adventure, the Pig Adventure, and the Crop Adventure to learn about the animals, farming practices and nutrition. We continue to Carmel, Indiana for our last night. **L**
