MOTORCOACH / FLY

1 SHENANDOAH VALLEY / HARRISBURG, PENNSYLVANIA

Our delightful journey begins with our becoming better acquainted with our tour director and other passengers with whom we will be spending the next 14 or 19 days. We have lunch near Salem, Virginia, and travel through the beautiful Shenandoah Valley on our way to Harrisburg, PA for our first night.

2 PORTSMOUTH, NEW HAMPSHIRE

Time passes quickly today as we travel through the states of Pennsylvania, New York, Connecticut and Massachusetts before entering New Hampshire. Early evening finds us arriving in Portsmouth, New Hampshire for overnight.

3 MONCTON, NEW BRUNSWICK

We have a short drive to Portland where we will make a photo stop at the Portland Headlight situated on the rugged coast of Maine. This is the oldest light house in continuous use in the United States. We continue northeast through Maine stopping for lunch in Bangor. After lunch we continue to Calais, Maine where we cross the border into New Brunswick, Canada and continue skirting St. John to Moncton, New Brunswick for overnight. Meet Fly in travelers at hotel this evening.

4 SYDNEY, NOVA SCOTIA / CORNER BROOK

Today we travel to the heart of Cape Breton Island to Baddeck and Arrive at Deer Lake on the West Coast of Newfoundland and transfer to Corner Brook to begin your holiday with McCarthy's Party. This evening we will enjoy a welcome reception to meet your fellow travellers and learn more about the adventure ahead. Overnight Corner Brook. Welcome Reception.

5 GROS MORNE NATIONAL PARK / PLUM POINT

This morning we take the Viking trail to beautiful Gros Morne National Park. We will travel along some of the most spectacular coastline in North America and visit the National Historic Park at Port au Choix, which interprets the intriguing history and lifestyle of the Maritime Archaic people who lived here over 3000 years ago. We stay two nights in Plum Point. **B L D**



6 ST. ANTHONY / UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE L'ANSE AUX MEADOWS

Today we travel the coastline to St. Anthony to visit the home of the famous medical missionary, Sir Wilfred Grenfell. The highlight of this day is our visit to the UNESCO World Heritage site at L'Anse aux Meadows, home of Lief the Lucky and the Viking people who settled this area as early as the year 1000 A.D. **B L**

7 STRAITS OF BELLE ISE / LABRADOR

Keep a sharp eye out for whales as we travel across the Straits of Belle Isle to the shores of Labrador. Here we visit the recently discovered Whaling Station founded by the Basques in the early 1500's, and learn about the "modern techniques" used by these whalers and the hardships they endured. Later we visit the tallest lighthouse in the province at L'Anse Amour before checking into our hotel for the night in L'Anse Amour. **B L**

8 THE ARCHES / ROCKY HARBOR / COW HEAD

This morning we return to the island and continue to explore the rugged coastline stopping to visit The Arches and enjoy an interpretation of the many unique and wonderful geological formations for which Newfoundland is so famous. Tonight we will enjoy a traditional Newfoundland dinner. We spend two nights in either Rocky Harbor or Cow Head. **B D**



9 BOONE BAY/WOODY POINT / UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE IN GROS MORNE NATIONAL PARK

This morning we take a boat tour across beautiful Bonne Bay to Woody Point where we spend time in Gros Morne National Park UNESCO World Heritage Site. We visit the new Discovery Centre and view the famous Tableland Mountains. It is this area that earned the park its UNESCO World Heritage status and its nickname as the 'Galapagos of Plate Tectonics'. We return to our hotel at Rocky Harbour or Cow Head area for the night. **B L**
