


MOTORCOACH

**1 SHENANDOAH VALLEY/CHAMBERSBURG, PENNSYLVANIA**  
We board our deluxe motorcoach traveling northeast through East Tennessee as our journey continues through the Shenandoah Valley region of Virginia to Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, for the night.

**2 TOUR AMISH COUNTRY / KITCHEN KETTLE VILLAGE DINNER AND THE QUEEN ESTHER SHOW**
