**Board of Directors** – Board Members are selected through an annual election process by Chamber members.

**Executive Committee** – serves as the officers of the Chamber Board of Directors. They are selected from within the Board of Directors annually.

**Agricultural Committee** - Plan and coordinate the annual Ottawa County Premium Sale; assist in fundraising effort; provide volunteer assistance during the actual sale event.

**Ambassadors** - The Ambassadors are a group of members who believe in serving as the goodwill arm of the Chamber. They serve as event greeters, new business welcoming team, coordinators of ribbon cuttings and groundbreakings and serve as a voice for business to the Chamber staff and board. Serving as an Ambassador gives you or your employees an opportunity to build relationships with other business and puts your company in the limelight of involvement.

**Business Development Committee** - Plan and implement business education programming (seminars and workshops); plan and coordinate the Women in Business program; work in conjunction with MAEDS to plan and coordinate a new Business Expo. Other programming may develop during committee meetings.

**Community Leadership Committee** - Plan and coordinate the Leadership and Youth Leadership Programs to educate and engage future leaders within our community; review and determine involvement with Bright Futures or other community resource programs. Other programming may develop during committee meetings.

**Governance Committee** - Coordinate election of Board of Directors, selection of Officers, annual overview of bylaws, personnel, and operational policies to ensure all best practices are in place to create a Chamber of Excellence.

**Government Affairs Committee** (Joint Committee with MRCC & MAEDS) - Coordinate programming to ensure our Members are The Voice of Business through event hosting of Candidate Forums, Eggs & Issues Breakfast, State of the Community, State of the State, Congressional Luncheon, and Goodwill Trip to the Capitol. Establish policy priorities and act on issues that affect business in Miami, Ottawa County and Northeastern Oklahoma.

**Membership Committee** - Establish and coordinate new member programs, coordinate the retention and growth of membership, and implement member services and benefit programming.

**Retail Committee** - Establish retail program through focus group discussions with retailers, implement programming that benefit retailers. Plans and coordinates events beneficial to retailers.
