Dear Friend,


At Cancer Support Community Arizona, we have been closely monitoring Coronavirus (COVID-19). While we were putting in place sanitizing measures and recommendations, we also instituted some common-sense social distancing. Through the process, **it became evident that these measures alone were no longer enough to keep our higher risk population safe. Therefore, based on the direction from our local health department and in accordance with state officials and CDC guidelines, Cancer Support Community Arizona has made the difficult decision to postpone all in-person daily programs at our Central Phoenix, Flagstaff and at all off-site locations for the time being.**

During this time, we are putting in place a plan to provide some of our programs virtually. Specific members of our staff will be providing further updates with you about a virtual online connection accessible from any smart phone or computer. This will allow anyone impacted by cancer, new or existing participants, the opportunity to receive our support from the comfort of their home or office. We will continue to welcome new program participants and work with individuals and families one on one as appropriate via telephone and email. Given the quickly evolving nature of this health threat, we will continue to monitor daily and make additional changes as needed. We will update you as these changes occur.
