# Treasure hunting

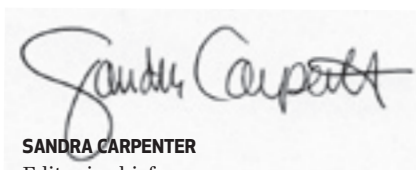
