<p><b>**Standard Pleat**</b> (Pinch pleat, 3-finger pleat, French pleat)</p> 	<p><b>**Standard Pleat w/ Center Tack**</b></p> 	<p><b>**Standard Pleat w/ Top Tack**</b> (Parisian Pleat, Brisby Pleat, Tailored Pleat)</p> 
<p><b>**2-Fold pleat**</b> (2-Prong Pleat, 2-Finger Pleat)</p> 	<p><b>**2-fold w/ Center Tack**</b></p> 	<p><b>** 2-fold w/ Top Tack**</b> (Euro Pleat)</p> 
<p><b>**Single Pleat **</b> (1-Prong pleat, 1-Finger Pleat)</p> 	<p><b>**Inverted Box pleat**</b></p> 	<p><b>**Stitch for Hooks**</b> (Flat Style, can add memory tape to keep folds in place like Ripple)</p>
