STUDENT COMMUNITY SERVICE CRITERIA
HIGH SCHOOL ~ GRADES 7 - 12**

1. Students cannot be paid.
2. Students cannot replace a paid worker.
3. Generally the agencies or organizations should be non-profit. Some exceptions apply, such as hospitals and nursing homes, but students may not participate in actual profit-making functions of any business.
4. There must be an identified need for student service.
5. Course credit may not be earned for the service hours provided.
6. Students will receive credit for church/community service hours only after:
 - a. Receiving signatures from the supervisor and parent/guardian.
 - b. Completed form(s) given to proper school authority.
7. Students need to complete a minimum of 75 hours of service as part of their graduation requirements.
8. Grace Academy is not responsible for accidents or injuries which may occur while students are performing individual hours of service in their community or church.
