- Communion will be done seated with prepackaged juice and wafer.
- Please do not attend in person if you are not feeling well or if you have been exposed to Covid-19, traveled internationally or to any location identified as a hot spot for Covid-19 in the last 14 days. We request that you continue to take advantage of our online worship service.
- If you are at high risk due to health or age, we want you to be safe so please consider continuing to take advantage of our Zoom worship service.
