



Curling Operations with Public Safety in Mind

If you are feeling ill, have a fever, have a cough, shortness of breath, or if you have any reason to believe you may have been exposed to the COVID virus, DO NOT CURL and call health links at 1-888-315-9257

- Please ensure social distancing at all times.
- We can not offer brooms and equipment for people to use due to CoVid. You must have your own equipment.
- Every curler will have to sign a Curl Canada waiver and provide contact information.
- All curlers will be tracked for every draw for contact tracing.

On the Ice.....

- Curlers will enter the ice at the west side door and exit the ice at the east side door
- No hand shakes
- No coin flips, instead use another method like “rock, paper, scissors” or an online tool on your phone: <https://justflipacoin.com/>
- Only one person on the benches at a time
- One designated person will keep score for both teams
- One designated person will conduct all measures. They must sanitize their hands before and after the measure.
- Only touch the handle of your own rocks. We will sanitize the rocks between draws.
- One sweeper only on all delivered stones. The person in charge of the house is not allowed to sweep under any circumstance. The skip of the non-delivering team must remain in the hack area until all stones come to rest. They are not allowed to sweep the opposition stone behind the tee-line. Lessening of physical distancing restrictions would/could allow this guideline to be removed.
- Players stay on the same side of the sheet. For example, if you are playing on sheet 2, always walk or position yourself on the sideline to sheet 1. This will keep players 10 feet apart.
- Two New small markings at the side of the middle of the sheet, where non delivering team sweepers stand. Next thrower to stand at hog line.

Off the ice....

- Masks will be required in the building unless you are on the ice, or sitting at a table in the restaurant
- All curlers will enter the building through the east door and exit through the east door.
- The upstairs can be accessed through the west stairwell, and you can leave the restaurant through the east stairwell.
- Lockers will be available
- The bleachers have marked areas for seating.
- Hand sanitizers are located throughout the club rooms
- There will be no self serve options including ice area water tank, kleenex, popcorn, etc.
