



How to become an Affiliated Nellis Family Child Care (FCC) Provider

Individuals who are interested in becoming a Family Home Day Care Provider and who live in the Las Vegas/Henderson/Indian Springs community can become affiliated with Nellis AFB to provide childcare to military families. There are great benefits to being affiliated such as free trainings, access to materials and equipment for your program, financial assistance for NAFCC Accreditation and Child Development Associate (CDA) credentials! To become affiliated you ***MUST BE*** licensed through the State of Nevada. Air Force training can be completed in your home while you are completing your State licensing. Once you receive your State License, you will also receive Air Force Affiliation Certification.

The Air Force affiliation process requires you to be at least 18 years of age, able to speak, read and write English, and in good mental and physical health. You and your family members must pass a comprehensive background check and complete 40hrs of orientation/training prior to becoming affiliated. Further, unannounced home inspections are conducted monthly to ensure that every provider is consistently maintaining all Air Force standards in addition to the standards of the state and county.

Providing child care makes a great supplementary income for your household for individuals who stay at home, go to school or want to be at home with their children.
