April 10 – May 3, 2020

The Mt. Airy Art Garage (MAAG) is holding an open call for artists to submit for “*Our Battles*,” happening from April 10 - May 3, 2020 at the Suzanne Roberts Theatre at 480 S. Broad St., Philadelphia, PA., 19146.

Our Battles is the final of three exhibits MAAG will mount at The Philadelphia Theatre Company this season in conjunction with their production of *The Wolves*. What does it mean to be a teenager? For this exhibit, we’re encouraging our artists to describe and show one of the most transformational periods of their lives. What were the internal or external battles you waged? We encourage artists to submit up to two (2) pieces of work to be on display and for sale in this upcoming exhibit.

The Wolves by Sarah DeLappe is the story of nine young women from a competitive high school soccer team as they push and train for games while also navigating the trials and tribulations of their fast-changing lives. From Harry Potter to the Khmer Rouge, from ambition to abortion, *The Wolves* is about life, love, and loss on and off the Astroturf.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

MAAG welcomes all artists, from emerging to professional. We also strive for excellence and professionalism in presenting artwork. Therefore, all work must be professionally presented and properly finished.

- All works of art must be original, done by the artist, and ready to hang. All two dimensional media considered.
- Each artist can submit up to 2 pieces of art, not to exceed 4'x4'.
- It is recommended that the artist be present for the preview and the opening.
- The commission on work sold during the event is 30%.
- All works of art must reflect the theme of the show and be the work that was submitted to the jury.
- All artists are encouraged to engage in gallery sitting at least once.
- MAAG does have insurance on exhibited works, which covers the costs of the materials only. All work is insured only for the duration of the show. Any pieces not picked up after the due dates are not insured.
