Visiting Priest Next Weekend & 2nd Collection—Fr. José Nieto was ordained a priest on May 17, 2014, for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. He is from a small town on the Caribbean Coast of Colombia. He grew up in Colombia, and after finishing his degree in civil engineering he joined the Community of Saint Paul and moved to Dominican Republic in 2004.

While in the Dominican Republic, he lived and worked in *La Sagrada Familia* Parish, which is in the southwest corner of the country, close to the border with Haiti. He was there for five years helping with the missionary work of the Community of Saint Paul.

Afterwards he moved to Milwaukee to finish his theological studies at Saint Francis de Sales Seminary and Sacred Heart School of Theology. From June 2014 to June 2018, Fr. José worked as the associate pastor at Saint William and Saint John Neumann parishes in Waukesha, Wisconsin. By the request of his Archbishop Fr. José moved to Washington DC in 2018 to complete further studies in Scripture at Catholic University of America.

In his appeals, Fr. José will be asking for support for the work that the Community of Saint Paul continues to do in Dominican Republic and Colombia.
