SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. STUDY THE SCRIPTURE

Review the scriptures from the first point of the sermon notes. What is the origin of sex and how does this impact how we should approach it? In what ways does sex function as a gift from God? How does our culture view sex and how does this compare to God's view?
