## OBSTACLES – Liberty Advanced

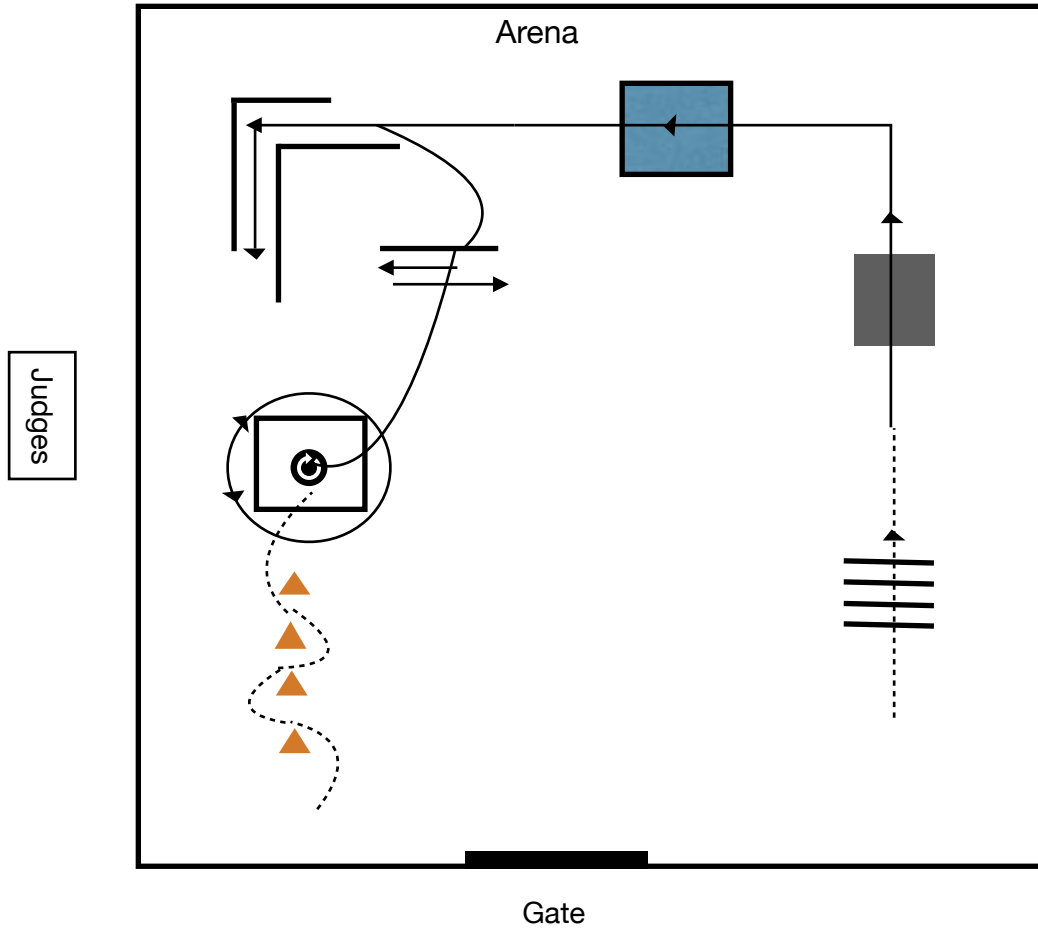
NOTE: Pattern can be completed with horse either besides or following handler.

1. Trot horse over poles (with horse at the right shoulder of trainer)
  - 1/5-point deduction for every pole that the trainer goes over
  - 1/5-point deduction for any pole that the horse dings
2. Walk over bridge (with horse at the right shoulder of trainer)
  - 1-point deduction if trainer steps on bridge
3. Walk over tarp (with horse at the right shoulder of trainer)
  - 1-point deduction if trainer steps on tarp
4. Walk through L shaped poles and stop (with horse at the right shoulder of trainer)
  - 1-point deduction for every time trainer steps inside L shaped poles
5. Back through L shaped poles (with horse at the right shoulder of trainer)
  - 1-point deduction for every time trainer steps inside L shaped poles
6. Side pass ( R ) over poles
7. Side pass ( L ) over poles
8. Stop horse in pole square
9. Have horse do a full pivot turn inside the square. 1 turn each way
10. Walk 1 circle either direction (your choice) around horse while horse stays in square
11. Handler to stand inside square and then send horse two ( 2 ) circles at the trot around square to the left
12. Change of direction at the trot
13. Handler to stand inside square and then send horse two ( 2 ) circles at the trot around square to the right
  - NOTE: Each time that trainer steps out of square once horse is trotting is a 1/5-point deduction.
  - Each time horse steps inside square once horse is trotting is a 1/5-point deduction
14. Weave through cones at a trot (with horse at the right shoulder of trainer)

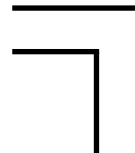

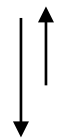
