



Philanthropy

The project requires a **\$50 million fundraising campaign**. For Wake Forest Baptist, it is the most significant capital improvement project reliant upon philanthropy in decades.

Timing

Construction is under way and will be completed in time to welcome medical students in July 2016.

Reducing Costs

By starting the project before Dec. 31, 2014, Wake Forest Baptist capitalized on available **historic tax credits that will trim more than \$30 million from the total cost**.
