- #7 Find ways to connect your freshmen to the school beyond Freshman Focus.
- #8 Solicit feedback from your faculty advisor to build and improve your leadership skills.
- #9 Create a positive Freshman Focus classroom environment and maintain it throughout the year.
- #10 Celebrate the successes of your freshmen.
