

*Statutes of the State of Nevada passed at the Sixteenth Session of the Legislature, 1893.*

CHAP. III. – *An Act to amend an Act entitled “An Act relative to attorneys and counsellors-at-law,” approved October 31, 1861.*

[Approved January 31, 1893]

*The People of the State of Nevada, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section two of said Act is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

Section two. Any citizen of the United States of the age of twenty-one years, of good moral character, and who possesses the necessary qualification of learning and ability, shall be entitled to admission as attorney and counsellor in all the courts of this State. Under this Act females shall have the same rights and privileges as males.
