

## Planning of assessment

Following is the checklist that every NPO should follow before designing any impact assessment for their program-



Who are you seeking to influence or benefit (target population)?



How will you and others make this happen (activities, strategies, resources, etc.)?



What benefits are you seeking to achieve (results)?



Where and under what circumstances will you do your work?



When will you achieve them (time period)?



Why do you believe your theory will bear out (assumptions)?

## Designing an Impact study

Impact assessment comes down to two major tasks-first, is asking if the **intervention has met real needs** and the second is accommodating results to **achieve better results**.
