Janjagruti Vidyarthi Sangh (JVS) is a Non-Government Organization (NGO), established in 1997, to change the lives of children and needy people as well. JVS runs various programmes to empower the people and also to solve their problems for the betterment of their lives.

Partnership and participation is the key of JVS's activities. The person from the same community can very well understand the problems of that community. JVS has most of the local volunteers and participants as well. JVS gets good support from the local NGOs and local people, which is beneficial for the project and the people as well.

The coronavirus COVID-19 has spread across multiple countries and infected thousands of people. The virus has caused more than 3,50,000 deaths worldwide. In the recent outbreak of Corona Virus in India, We have started Corona relief support work during the lockdown period for the poor and daily wage labourers who are suffering from no income and struggling to meet their daily needs. Currently we manage to support in our working areas which are various slums situated in Mankhurd, Govandi, Chembur & Mulund area of Mumbai as well as some slum areas in Pune.

We are supporting our communities by :

- 1) Distributed **COOKED FOOD PACKETS** from **24<sup>th</sup> March 2020**, started with **300 food packets daily**, currently **distributing 13,000 cooked food** packets daily in Maharashtra, Jantanagar, Ekta Nagar, Matangrushinagar, Rahul nagar, Sathenagar in MANKHURD AND Mohd. Rafinagar, Sanjaynagar, Shantingar in GOVANDI. .
- 2) Running **3 Community Kitchens** in **1) Shivneri nagar Mankhurd, 2) Indira Nagar, Mankhurd, & 3) Sanjaynagar, Govandi** which provides food for **1800 individuals daily** from difficult to reach areas of community.
- 3) Distributed **DRY RATION RELIEF KITS** for our Migrant Workers, Daily Wage Labours, Domestic worker / Senior citizen families, Single parent headed families etc.

From 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020 till date, we have distributed **4778 Dry Ration Kits** in our various communities situated in Chembur, Mankhurd, Govandi & Dharavi **which supports approx. 22000 people**.

- 4) Distributed **HYGIENE KITS** (Sanitizer, Dettol liquid, Masks 5 per pack, Gloves – 5 pairs, Sanitary Pads) to local families – **100 Hygiene Kits Distributed in Maharashtra to Migrant Labour families**.

Distributed **4000 Sanitary pads packets, 4000 Handgloves pair, 3000 Masks** in Rahulnagar & Chikuwadi from Mankhurd & Sanjaynagar, Govandi.

- 5) Distributed **SANITIZERS TO COMMUNITY TOILETS & BUILDING PREMISES: DISTRIBUTED HYGIENE KIT TO 54 COMMUNITY TOILETS** IN MANKHURD, GOVANDI, BHANDUP, MULUND IN MUMBAI AND **10 COMMUNITY TOILETS IN PUNE**

each kit includes – 10 Masks, 30 Gloves, 10 Ltr, Sanitizer Spray for Community toilet premises users.

As well as Distributed **Standing sanitizer Stand with 2 liter sanitizer each for 15 buildings of Chikuwadi SRA Society** to used by passers before entering in Building.

All these abovesaid works were done by our Trustees Mr. Santosh Surve, Mr. Prajit Gaikwad, Mr. Rativ Patil, Mr. Baburao Kattimani, Mr. Suresh Kattimani, Mr. Bhima Khandeka & Coordinator Mrs. Geeta Surve, as well as total 31 volunteers who have worked very hard in this pandemic to reach all our beneficiaries with guiding all about social distancing & precautions.
