



Process for sharing GVD Biodiversity Trust information and data to third parties

Context

The Great Victoria Desert (GVD) Biodiversity Trust is governed by a Management Panel. The purpose and role of the Management Panel (in addition to that described in Clause 9.2 of the Deed) is to:

'make research and other information relating to the Trust Area obtained through the implementation of the Trust Purposes available to the public and third parties working in, or having an interest in conservation, the Trust Area or commitments similar to the Trust Purposes'.

This document outlines the process by which third parties may access and use Trust research and other information, as described in the Trust Deed.

Process

1) Third party submits a request to the Trust Operations Manager (Data Custodian) (operations.manager@gvdbiodiversitytrust.org.au) with the following information on a Proforma template (GVD BIODIVERSITY TRUST

INFORMATION AND DATA REQUEST FORM):

- a) Agency/organisation requesting use of the information
- b) Date of request
- c) Type of information requested
- d) Purpose of use
- e) Map or coordinates of location where information is sought from.
- f) Special requirements to access data (e.g. special permissions for data collected on country of Traditional Owners).

2) Operations Manager processes the request, solicits special requirements for data collected on country of Traditional Owners, and shares the requested information to the third party online.
