



## Drive with CARE Program – Request a Presenter at Your School or Community Group

The **Drive with CARE** presentation is *usually* conducted in a classroom setting for 45-50 minutes. It is an interactive discussion about Graduated Driver Licensing Laws, traffic safety laws and violation penalties, courteous driving vs aggressive driving, distracted driving, impaired driving and seat belt use. Depending on availability, the presentation can be expanded and include impaired goggles and the driving simulator.

**Difficulty Level:** Easy

### Implementation Timeframe:

Any time throughout the school year

### What goes into hosting a successful speaker presentation at your school or community organization?

1. Begin by getting approval from your Principal, Program Director or Driver Education Instructor to help determine who might need to be involved, as well as when the presentation could be held. Usually the presentations are conducted in a classroom (45-50 minutes), however, it can be amended to fit other settings!
2. When working with your student advisor, school administration, or community leadership, **define a couple of dates and times** that would be appropriate to hold a school/community-wide speaker presentation.
3. **A Drive with CARE program presentation requires audio & visual needs.** Please work with your school or community group to ensure there is audio and visual support for the presentation, and a location or classroom is available for the presentation on your set day. (Liz can provide the projector if needed.)
4. Contact Elizabeth (Liz) Willis (contact information below) to discuss presentation/event opportunities.
5. Formally set an exact date and time with Liz, and your school or community organization.
6. Prior to the event and on the day, be sure to advertise event with flyers, school announcements, etc.



Event Idea: Elizabeth can present the Drive with CARE to the individual Driver Education Classes, and also set up the driving simulator and drunk goggles in the lunch area during the schools' lunch hour.
