**Brewer of the Year: Trophy & Certificate**

To be eligible a person/syndicate must enter at least 3 competitions. The best scores gained from 1st, 2nd, or 3rd are used to find the average points of three competitions. All results must be at least bronze standard. All beers will be judged according to BJCP guidelines.
