

Custer Township Board Meeting Minutes

March 15 2021

Supervisor Mark Anderson Called the regular meeting to the Custer Township Board to Order at 1:30pm. Members attending besides Supervisor Mark Anderson were Larry Larr, Trustee; George Allison, Trustee; Staci Wood, Clerk; missing members Carey Jolly, Treasurer.

The minutes for the February Custer township Board meeting were presented for review. With no discussion or changes forth coming Larry made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. George seconded the motion; ayes=4 nays=0 motion carried.

Mark presented the bills for review. George made a motion to pay the bills presented, Larry seconded the motion; ayes=4, nays=0 motion carried.

Visitor's present were Mary Samuels from the Mason County Road Commission, Ron Bacon and Sherriff Kim Cole.

Mary Spoke about some road improvements and the new Road commission Building, she also spoke about putting in a county wide fueling station to be used by all county government service vehicles school busses, patrol cars, fire depts etc. Mary said she received a bid for a new improved road brine that will cost more but is supposed longer lasting and more effective going to do some test runs in the fall.

Sherriff Cole wanted to thank the fire dept for the great work they did in a fatal car accident that happened in Branch twp. He also informed us about a continued problem they have been having with huffing in Mason County and how he hopes to get help with housing inmates with mental issues somewhere safe for them instead of in the jail to get the proper care they need. Gave the monthly police report as well.

Clerk's Report:

Received a deposit for the hall rental in May spoke about taking Covid precautions during the rental. All were in favor of renting out as long as it was held outside of the hall with food preparations done in side.

Mark and I took the Vat Machines to the court house on March 4th 2021 to have them tested for the May voting. Was able to meet with Cheryl Kelly and her team and was given some insight on elections. I was able to post times I would be at the hall for Absentee ballots the weekend prior to the Voting.

Mark and I were given a request for Allocated Millage we need to turn into Cheryl Kelly before April 1, 2021 for the first meeting of the Allocated Board will be Monday April 19, 2021.

George Allison brought to our attention that he wasn't sure if he got paid for the month of November 2020 and put money in his retirement as well. There was a check issued to George in November but was never cashed and his retirement was paid in November as well.

I received a phone call from Scott Hansen asking to have his Gas card turned back on for the Summer, he also asked about Cemetery clean up for this year as well.

The Credit card for Ann Larr was canceled and a new card issued for Staci Wood.

Treasurer's Report:

Mark presented that tax season is over and the settlement came out. Still waiting for the check from delinquent taxes from Mason County Treasurer.

Both tax accounts have a zero balance at this time funds have been transferred from tax savings account to Business Township savings account.

A Resolution for online banking was presented to the board by Mark Anderson, Larry made a motion to sign the resolution. Seconded by George; ayes=4, nays=0 motioned carried.

Supervisor's Report:

Mark spoke about the website changing companies and that we now have access to the back end of the website so we can make changes ourselves. Stated he is waiting for the amounts from the Board of Review to be able to fill out the Allocated Millage form for the County Clerk.

Mark met with the Water Shed Council they want to help us with rules on the river. Henry's Landing wants to come again this year and have a river area near the boat launch board has agreed to let them.

Mark Presented the Budget Report for review went over some of the changes he made to the report.

Mark Stated Josh Powers will be at the April Township meeting to speak about the arch way he is willing to build for the Cemetery.

Mark said we need to investigate the outstanding Checks on the Treasurer's report and get them cleared up.

Mark spoke with the MTA they gave the okay to pay the Clerk \$500.00 after each election.

With no other business presented to the board Larry made the motion to adjourn, George seconded; ayes=4 nays=0 Motion carried. Next Meeting April 19, 2021
