



Million Dollar Hole in One Challenge Rules & Regulations

Each qualifier must be an amateur (no professionals) and a minimum of 18 years old to participate as of July 6, 2019.

No employees, family members, or contractors of the Western Canadian Golf Foundation, Linx Marketing and 1932byBateman are eligible to participate.

Each qualifier will make a \$50 donation with net proceeds going to CASA and YOUCAN Youth Services. For each \$50 donation, the qualifier will receive one qualifying shot for closest to the pin and two weekly passes to the 1932byBateman Open (valued at \$150). *Note: due to CRA regulations, a tax receipt will not be issued as the benefits from the donation have more much more value.*

Random draw from all participants at all courses for four (4) extra spots into the Final.

Name will be entered for \$10,000 in prizes. A random draw to take place during the Million Dollar Hole in One Challenge Final on Saturday, August 3 after 5 pm (must be in attendance to win).

On July 6-7 (*alternate/rainout weekend July 13-14*), there will be a 2-day qualifying event at each participating golf course where a par 3 has been identified and a closest to the pin competition will be conducted for all paid participants who are playing the course that day. The pin will remain in the same location for the two days of the competition.

A player may attempt the shot more than once during the weekend by playing a second round and making an additional \$50 donation. Only one attempt may be made per 18-hole round.

In the case of inclement weather, the qualifying golf course may choose to allow the participant to hit their qualifying shot without playing the full 18 holes.

When qualifiers arrive at the designated par 3, a volunteer from CASA or YOUCAN will be situated at the green to measure the closest to the pin for participating players. When qualifiers approach the green, they will advise the volunteer that you signed up for the Challenge, and they will measure your shot. Participant results will be cross-referenced with the master list of registrants in the pro shop and the player who is closest to the pin will advance to the Final that will be played on Saturday, August 3 at the Edmonton Country Club following tournament play. Winners will be notified via email and phone.

Measurements will be done from the edge of the cup to the closest edge of the golf ball.

Measurements will be kept confidential until the end of the weekend.

If you make a hole in one during the qualification, you will receive a Lexus to drive during the tournament week (compliments of Lexus South Pointe) and will also receive on-site VIP parking. In the case of a hole in one, the person who is closest for the weekend at the particular club will also receive an entry into the shootout.

In case of inclement weather, the qualifying weekend may shift from July 6-7 to July 13-14 (and even as late as July 20-21) as determined by the qualifying club.

A total of 32 participants will advance into the Finals to take place at the Edmonton Country Club on Saturday, August 3 following tournament play (approx. 5 pm).

- The top qualifier from each participating course will receive entry to the Finals (16 qualifiers)
- Two (2) media will be selected from the Media Challenge to participate in the Finals
- Four (4) winners of the closest to the pin contest during the Official Sponsor Pro-Am will also receive entry into the Finals
- Three (3) qualifiers from the on-site event day qualifying (Thurs-Sat) will also receive entry into the Finals
- A minimum of four (4) randomly drawn winners up to a maximum of seven (7) from all shootout entries
- Each of the 32 qualifiers will receive:
 - One shot at making a hole in one for \$1,000,000*.
 - 10 grounds passes for Saturday's competitive round to distribute to their friends to come on-site watch the golf and then cheer them on at the Shootout

The order of play of the 32 participants will be through a random draw

Each of the 32 participants will hit one shot from 175 yards. Only the first hole in one made will receive \$1 Million Dollars*

- The top 4 closest to the pin Finalists will win a prize
- During the Shootout there will be a random draw of \$10,000 in prizes drawn from all qualifying participants. Draw will be conducted from least valuable prizes to the most valuable. Winning names will not be entered back into the draw as qualifiers are only eligible to win one prize.
- There will be a BBQ, beer gardens, music and prize presentation for all participants to enjoy after the shootout.

*Only the first hole in one will receive \$1,000,000

Prize indemnity policy document is available on request. Hole in One golf conditions are as follows:

1. The following are added to the Declarations:

Hole number:	#18
Distance from the tee:	175 yards
Maximum number of contestants:	32
Maximum number of rounds:	1
Maximum number of shots:	32
Name(s) and address(es) of witness(es):	Loss adjuster to be present from MGB claims

2. The following **CONDITIONS** are added:
 - a. The tournament must adhere to the rules of the Professional Golfers Association or the Royal and Ancient Golf Club.
 - b. The equipment must adhere to the specifications of the Professional Golfers Association or the Royal and Ancient Golf Club.
 - c. The hole number stated in the Declarations must not:
 - i. be less than the distance from the tee stated in the Declarations;
 - ii. be altered in any way from normal play conditions; and
 - iii. in a position on the golf course which would make the insured attempt easier to claim the **prize**.
 - d. The following shall not exceed the amounts stated in the Declarations:
 - i. maximum number of contestants;
 - ii. maximum number of rounds; and
 - iii. maximum number shots.
3. If the value of the **prize** is:
 - a. between \$5,000 and \$25,000 the insured event must be witnessed by one person; or
 - b. between \$25,001 and \$50,000 the insured event must be witnessed by:
 - i. two persons; or
 - ii. one person and the insured event must be recorded; or
 - c. \$50,001 or more and above the insured event must be witnessed by two persons and the insured event must be recorded.
4. Any witness of the insured event must be approved by **us**. The approved witness(es) are stated in the Declarations.
5. The recording of the insured event must clearly show:
 - a. the position of the contestant in relation to the tee;
 - b. the swing of the contestant;
 - c. the path of the ball;
 - d. the landing spot of the ball;
 - e. the ball dropping into and remaining in the cup;
 - f. the ball being removed from the cup by the witness stated in the Declarations;
 - g. all eligible shots.

The recording must not be edited.

6. The following **EXCLUSION** is added:

Prize offer claim by an approved witness

if the **prize** is claimed by the witness(es) stated in the Declarations.

7. The following is added to "How to make a claim under this Policy":

In the event of a claim, **you** must provide **us** with:

- a. the winning contestant's card counter-signed by an opponent or the witness stated in the Declarations; and
- b. a copy of the recording of the insured attempt.

SUBJECT OTHERWISE TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE POLICY
