2-1-1 Arizona Day Telethon Fundraiser Tomorrow February 11 (2-11) 2016!

Phoenix, Arizona - Community Information and Referral Services (CIR), provider of statewide 2-1-1 Arizona services will be holding its third annual telethon fundraiser in honor of **2-1-1 Arizona Day** tomorrow on **Thursday, February 11, 2016**. Through a statewide proclamation issued by Governor Doug Ducey, 2-1-1 Arizona has been recognized as “invaluable to the continued health and well-being of many Arizonans.”

2-1-1 is the easy to remember three-digit dialing number designated in 2000 by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) for easy access to information and referrals for health, community, government and human services. 2-1-1 Arizona was started in 2011 and benefits include:

- Easy access to vital community, health, and human service programs available in Arizona.
- Coordination of volunteer needs and opportunities.
- Demographic feedback on trends in needs, services, gaps, and poverty areas.
- Acts as a support system for emergency 9-1-1 operatives and disaster relief

With over 1.3 million service requests fulfilled last year, CEO Catherine Rea is taking this opportunity to go directly to the public to help fund 2-1-1 Arizona services. “We are holding our third Annual Telethon for 2-1-1 Arizona and asking the community to simply dial 2-1-1 or go to our website at www.211Arizona.org to donate.” Staff and volunteers will be accepting donations and pledges from 7 am to 6 pm tomorrow **Thursday, February 11th, 2016**. Community Information and Referral Services (CIR) was founded in 1964 and incorporated in 1979 as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and 2-1-1 Arizona provides information and referrals for human, health, government and faith-based services available in the State of Arizona. 2-1-1 Arizona currently refers to over 37,000 services provided by participating agencies and community programs, and assisted Arizona residents with over 1.3 million service requests fulfilled in FY 2015.
