Here at A Blessing to the Nations, as we begin our 18th season of ministry and 15 of those years being full-time ministry, we are still in awe that God still continues to use this ministry. The beginning of the year began like any other year with plans for trips to teach, preach, and train more believers in evangelism. In the early part of 2020, we prepared and completed several campaigns and lives were changed as we took many future evangelists to the streets to continue the original vision God gave us in 2003. Then, in March, the pandemic hit while we were ministering in Guatemala.

We continued our campaign there, completing it, but we were very fortunate to get out of

As many of you know, my grandson Israel, found himself unable to leave Peru due to the implemented travel ban. He was and is fortunate to finally find a return flight to the US. He had to remain quarantined or shuttered for six months until we could get a humanitarian flight out of the country. Yes, indeed everyone will remember this year.

B2N however, continued to do ministry through our personally trained teams that minister in many foreign countries. I have ministered in Mexico, Peru, Chile, Costa Rica, Malaysia both East and West Malaysia, Ghana, Zambia, Guatemala, El Salvador and throughout Panama. All of those countries were shut down and allowed very little intercountry travel. With God's favor in this ministry we still continue to use the men and women that I was able to train and place locally during those years of extensive travel. I was shuttered here in the United States yet much was accomplished through the power of the Holy Spirit. Our teams continued to go out with great risk of Covid-19 and to do the work God has always called us to do. Despite the danger our job is to reach the hurting and those that are lost.

## 2020 Support

Every time I write a newsletter and then review it, I truly am amazed at what God has done through B2N.

Yes, we are in a year like no other time in our lifetime. There are still lost and hurting people that we can reach. As CEO and pastor/ leader of this ministry, I knew we must redefine the way we did ministry in the past and make sure basic needs of our team members were met.

Only then can B2N focus on those who are hurting physically before we approach their spiritual needs.

## South Africa: Simon Chapinga

This year we saw a need to have a mission room for Simon in Zambia when he travels there for preaching and training. B2N also helped his son take truck driving lessons and secure a CDL license. Simon will use

Simon had a blown engine in his ministry van and this mode of transportation is a basic need for a traveling evangelist like himself. We were able to replace it at minimum cost compared to a new van. We are excited to say that it is now back on the road for under \$1700.00.



## Kenya: Pastor Joshua

Pastor Joshua in Kenya had a bad transmission and we were able to get it fixed and back on the road for \$1,200.00. Pastor Joshua delivers food to more than 50 widows that we help to support. He also oversees getting them to the doctor when they need transportation. Thanks for your continuing support as they were greatly impacted by the AIDS epidemic that raged in Africa for so many years. That led to so many homeless women and children. The average monthly dollars of \$300.00 that we spend on these widows and children is small compared to the lives that you are helping us touch. Additional risks and costs brought on by COVID 19 has left an additional dependence on B2N.



## Panama: Betty Moodie and Sister

seems because of close living conditions those areas were hardest hit with the Coronavirus. They did manage to send teachings out that were playable on cell phones. They have also been able to do much humanitarian ministry in those remote villages and at a much greater risk than many of our other ministries. We ask that you continue to pray for their safety and health.



## Guatemala: Miguel

In Guatemala, Miguel has seen his church grow in the middle of a pandemic. He did a zoom service six nights a week and was able to add members when they finally could meet live. He did not stop the online teachings and even added some noon day teachings. Miguel continues to supplement his income by going to teach his school of prophets in different churches and has been successfully raising up the prophetic voice in Guatemala. Miguel continues to mentor young men who also have that call for ministry.

Miguel was in the process of planting our fourth church in Guatemala when the pandemic hit. It has been a slow go since the pandemic but Miguel, with help of B2N, will plant a church in a mountain village where there is only a satanic church to choose from.
