

Orientation and End of the month evaluation and feedback

1. ORIENTATION:

There is an orientation session on the first day of your hematology rotation. Dr Ramadan will meet with you at the start (First day) of your rotation at the hematology office (440-1144 Burrard St) for 30 minutes from 9:00 am to 9:30 am. (Alternately you will meet at St Paul's Hospital on ward 8D, but only if you are advised to do so in your orientation letter) You should make yourself familiar with this orientation package before you start your rotation.

If you have any problems that might impede your ability to keep up with your hematology rotation, such as sickness or family emergency, we strongly advise you to discuss your situation with Dr Ramadan. You should also notify the office (Tel: 604-684-2331) with your planned holidays at the beginning of the month and emergency holidays when they occur.
