Ms. Stienstra is a sociologist and senior researcher at the Federal Judicial Center, the United States federal judiciary's agency for research and education. Her research has focused on civil case management and dispute resolution in the U.S. trial and appellate courts. She has published extensively on court-related subjects, including studies of appellate procedure, trial court case management, and alternative dispute resolution. She is currently completing a study of ADR in eight federal district courts. Ms. Stienstra established the Center's Program for Consultations in Dispute Resolution, which assists the U.S. federal courts in examining their procedures for providing settlement assistance. She also regularly consults with court systems in other countries. She served as founding co-chair (with Sheila Purcell) of the Court ADR Committee of the American Bar Association's Dispute Resolution Section; served on the editorial board of the Dispute Resolution Section's publication, Dispute Resolution Magazine; and is a member of the American Bar Association and the Law & Society Association.
