Lunch on October 19th and lunch and dinner on October 20th are not provided. Students are required to pack their own food, or bring money to purchase their own meals. This is an overnight trip. There will be separate hotels for boys and girls. Students will share rooms at the hotel monitored by Upper Canada DSB staff and should pack clothing for the trip.
