# Disclaimer

## Cremation of Remains

- Cremation of the donor's remains shall be done at an independent, licensed crematory facility. DonorCure is not liable for any claims arising from the performance of such.
- Non-organic matters attached to the body such as dental fillings; bridgework; gold inlays, prostheses, and pieces of jewelry may be discarded without prior notification to the authorizing party.
- Due to the nature of body donation, DonorCure does not guarantee that all parts of the donor's body will be included in the cremated remains returned to the party designated in the Cremation Authorization.
- Should the authorizing party opt for the cremated remains to be scattered at sea, Donor Cure reserves the right to choose the time and date of the scattering in the Atlantic Ocean.
- DonorCure will arrange for cremation according to business needs and does not guarantee a specific time frame for return of cremated remains.

## Cost and Expenses Coverage

- DonorCure guarantees to cover all expenses related to body donation once a donor is accepted. Even if the donor is accepted during pre-screening, their medical condition and medical research needs at the time of passing will ultimately determine their eligibility. DonorCure reserves the right to decline any potential donor.
- If a donor is accepted but subsequently deemed to be unusable due medical information or body condition not revealed at the time of screening, all related costs and expenses will be paid by the authorizing party or legal next of kin.
- If a funeral home is contacted to transport the body prior to contacting DonorCure and DonorCure is unable to arrange a suitable pricing arrangement with them, DonorCure will cover only a reasonable transportation cost. The remainder shall be paid by the authorizing party or legal next of kin.
- If the individual making the donation later rescinds it or if a family member disputes the donation, all costs incurred in relation to the donation will be paid by the authorizing party or legal next of kin.
