COMMANDER'S NOTES

With our country politically divided, as it is today, we must be mindful that JWV is a Jewish organization with the purpose of helping Veterans and their families in need. We show ourselves being non-political through our actions with helping veterans despite their political affiliations. We are also a social group with members working together for a common purpose and need to stay focused on the camaraderie that is necessary for the Post to succeed. This does not mean that each member is not entitled to their own political opinion, but that opinion should not be shared at JWV Post sponsored events.

JWV Posts are prohibited by the JWV National Constitution to participate in any political event or support any particular political candidate running for office. This means that members of the JWV cannot wear their JWV hat at any political event.

When there is State or Federal legislation proposed that affects Veterans, I would expect that the JWV and its members would support that legislation if they so choose or propose its defeat. It would be appropriate for any member knowing of such pending legislation to bring it to the attention of Post 64 members through the Commander. In some cases, members of Post 64 could ask the JWV Department of Nevada to support a particular issue and take it to JWV National where there is a lobbyist for Veteran's issues on the JWV National staff.

On a lighter note, remember Poppy Days are coming up from November 7th through November 11th. Plan to sign up soon.
