“Dear Comrades, during these trying times, it is appropriate that Passover, a Holiday of hope and renewal, takes place this week. However, this year, these nights will be different from all other Passover nights. On Pesach, we recount the ten plagues which G-d inflicted on the people of Egypt, including the tenth, which called for the death of the firstborn son of each family. In order to ensure the safety of the Jews, G-d told them to stay in their homes and paint lamb’s blood on their doorposts so they would be “passed over” by this plague. Today, we are also called upon to remain indoors in order to protect ourselves and our families.
