## Dues

**Dues for Reading Bowl are \$150 per student.** This includes your team shirt. Checks should be made payable to Fulton Science Academy Private School. Please write "Science Olympiad Dues" on the Memo line. **Travel and tournament expenses are not covered by these dues.**

### Terms and Conditions:

1. Reading Bowl Team decisions are made by the Reading Bowl Head Coaches, with the additional input of parent coaches, administrators, and other FSA personnel. All team decisions made by the Head Coaches are final.
2. Students' classroom and standardized test/MAP scores and disciplinary records will be reviewed during the team selection process, and previous years' teachers may be consulted about the student during this process.
3. Team success is the priority over individual success.
4. Previous experience with Reading Bowl does not guarantee placement on the team. More students will be selected to join the FSA Reading Bowl team than will be allowed to compete in events. The students who compete in events will be selected based on their performance, behavior, grades, attendance, etc. Students who do not compete will still participate in the club and its other events.
5. Although some students are permitted to participate in other activities and Academic Teams, priority must be given to Reading Bowl if accepted. After school activities including clubs, sports competitions, Scouts and such cannot replace Reading Bowl weekday or weekend activities.
6. All school rules are in effect for all Reading Bowl activities whether on or off campus. Students must respect our equipment and clean up after themselves. Disrespect of teammates, coaches, and/or property will not be tolerated. Be considerate of event coaches – they are volunteering their time. Students can be removed from the team at any time for poor behavior and/or attendance!
