Volunteer Descriptions:

1. **Festival Office**

Position assists office personnel. handing out radios, T- shirts, picking up supplies, check disbursements, and assist the Festival Chair as assigned. Radio will be assigned.

2. **Load-In and Load Out**

Position starts on Friday and Sunday. Helping volunteers, and vendors load-in and load-out. Handling tools/ equipment, set up and pick-up signage, lifting, carrying, driving golf carts is required must have valid driver license. Radio will be assigned.

3. **Entrance/Exit Station**

Position is responsible to ensure attendees do not bring alcohol on Arizona Indian Festival venue on Saturday. Radio will be assigned.

4. **Hospitality Station**

Position is responsible for packaging and distributing snack sacks to festival participants, volunteers, village participants, and dance group participants.

5. **Artisan Check-In - Booth Watcher**

Position is responsible for assisting with artist and booth check-in and communicating festival information and requirements. Assist artist as needed.

6. **Performance Station**

Position is responsible for assisting with performer check-in and ensuring performers are ready to perform as scheduled.

7. **Water Station**

Position oversees selling water bottles during the festival and communicating with office staff to refill ice as needed. If water is sold position requires money handling experience. Radio will be assigned.

8. **Parking Lot – Saturday Only**

Position is responsible for monitoring access to parking lot for festival artisan, cultural performers, participants. Parking lot location 2nd and Drinkwater. Radio and golf card will be assigned.

Volunteers will receive a T-Shirt and if you volunteer all day you will receive a food voucher. All volunteers will have access to hospitality area. Please check in at the volunteer AAITA information tent located on the North side of the Scottsdale Center for the Performing Arts building and South side of bridge.
