The selected candidate shall receive a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.

Application package should include:

1. Scholarship Application Form.
2. One-page personal written essay about one of the following topics:
 - a. ***Why have you chosen the field of Architecture?***
 - b. ***What do you wish to achieve after getting your undergraduate degree for Architecture?***
3. High School Transcript.
4. Copy of SAT or ACT scores if not included in transcript.
5. Two Letters of Recommendation from teachers with direct knowledge of candidate.
