**Big Valley Joint Unified School District:** Big Valley Joint Unified School District has set up a way for ALL students to receive nutritional meals during the closure from 3/19 to 4/10 to three "delivery sites" M-F. The breakfast and lunch will be delivered together, in one box or bag, according to the schedule and to locations shown below. **Modoc Joint Unified School District:** During the emergency school closure related to COVID-19, the Modoc Joint Unified School District will make available for pick-up on a daily basis a bag lunch for any children ages K-18. Distribution of the bag lunches will take place from 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. at the Modoc Middle School Parking lot beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020- Friday, March 20th. There will be a separate area for any students who walk. Meals will not be offered during Spring break.

- **Salvation Army Social Services:** Redding, CA 530-222-2207 *food and supplies* (Must show proof of residency and ID for certain services).
- **Groceries to Go:** Mayers Memorial Hospital Dist: M-F 9:00 AM-4:00 PM. Call 530-336-6880. For individuals 65 and older.
- **Great Northern Services:** We have staff answering phones Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., and we are open to the public at this point, but we encourage you to come in in-person only if absolutely necessary. As we see the impacts of COVID-19 hitting our local community, we anticipate the need for assistance with home energy bills to increase significantly. The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (#LIHEAP) may be able to help in many cases, but it's not an immediate assistance program. If your household income-qualifies or will qualify due to a reduction of your income in the next 30 days, we highly encourage you to start the application process now. You can request an application online (<https://www.gnservices.org>) or by calling (530) 938-4115 ext. 120.
