

## October 2020 Celilo Business Meeting Minutes

The President brought the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Secretary reported the minutes from the July meeting, as I wasn't present at the last meeting in August. The minutes from the August meeting are downloadable off the website if you're interested.

Treasures report is as follows: beginning balance of \$10,910.55 and ending balance of #11,198.91.

Old business: Nothing to report.

New business:

The club has a burn permit for the rest of the year.

Klickitat county is in the process of putting in an archery range at the port. They will have the need for target bales. The Club is offering them ours at \$60 each. Target bales to begin with, course bales when they are ready for them. Voted and passed the \$60 price.

Range master will finalize the target requirement estimated for the next year to include 3d and 2d targets at the November Meeting.

Work party set up for the 14<sup>th</sup> of November. Projects to include the removal of a tree leaning against the fence near the top of course a.

A shed needs to be available for the tractor that was donated by Tennison Orchards. A discussion was conducted and at the end the club has allocated \$3500 for a metal shed similar to the warming sheds. Minimum standards it was to have 3 walls, and large enough to house all the large equipment that is now being stored in the conex boxes. The goal was to have this done by the end of the year. Voted and passed.

Club Constitution and Bylaws a discussion of couple of sections. Question asked why was there was no provisions for absentee voting. Bottom line was that it would be too difficult to monitor and process absentee voting. The Constitution and bylaws were unanimously voted and passed as written. This document will be in effect immediately.

Membership signatures are to be required on all membership forms agreeing to abide by the Clubs constitution and Bylaws. Voted and passed.

3D shoot pricing for the Oct and Nov shoots. New pricing will be to change adult and youth to \$10. Voted and passed.

2021 3D shoots at the home range. The suggestion is to provide members a reduced price to encourage membership participation and new members benefits. After some discussion the following was suggested. Adult member single day \$10, two day \$20. Guest single day \$15, two day \$25. Youth member single day \$10, two day \$15. Guest youth single day \$15, two day \$20. Family member single day \$20, two day \$30. Guest family single day \$30, two day \$40. Voted and passed.

Membership Fees for 2021. After discussion it was voted and passed that the fees for membership will remain as they are. However, they will be re-visited in march 2021 for the 2022 year.

Propane bottle for the cook shack needs to be replaced. Discussion, purchase a new bottle. Voted and passed.

Propane plumbing. Discussion, at the work party to replace regulator and line with proper iron lines with shutoffs inside the cook shack. Voted and passed.

Surveillance camera for the property. Discussion, to purchase at \$40, two cameras and monitor and install them in the cook shack, one facing the parking lot and one the range. With a sign stating that the property is using video surveillance. Voted and passed.

For the Next two meetings in Nov and Dec they will be held at the Senior Center. The club will pay \$1 a head for the use of the facility. Voted and passed.
