

If God is for us, who is against us? ³²He who did not withhold his own Son, but gave him up for all of us, will he not with him also give us everything else? ³³Who will bring any charge against God’s elect? It is God who justifies. ³⁴Who is to condemn? It is Christ Jesus, who died, yes, who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who indeed intercedes for us.* ³⁵Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will hardship, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? ³⁶As it is written, ‘For your sake we are being killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep to be slaughtered.’

OPERATION BACKPACK is a community-wide effort to supply new backpacks and school supplies to needy children. Last year, Operation Backpack provided backpacks and school supplies to 1,050 children in Raleigh, Summers, Fayette and Wyoming counties. The following supplies are needed: backpacks, crayons, markers, glue (bottle and stick), pencils, notebook paper, 2 pocket folders, spiral notebooks, rulers, pencil pouches, erasers, eraser tops, pencil sharpeners, zippered notebooks (trapper keepers), calculators, 1" 3-ring binders, highlighters, pencil boxes and colored pencils. Backpacks can be clear or mesh, regular or messenger bags. Backpacks for preschoolers and elementary students need to be large enough to hold a two pocket folder. Backpacks for middle and high school students need to be large enough to hold a three ring binder. Monetary donations will be accepted. Please bring donations to the church by **August 7**.
